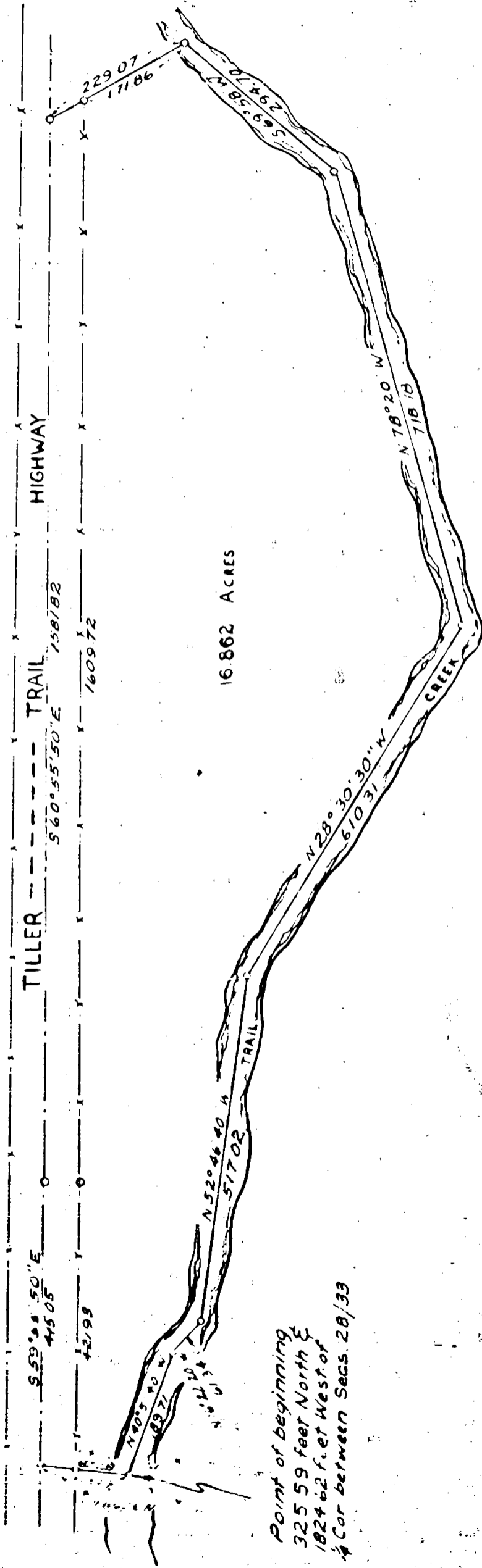
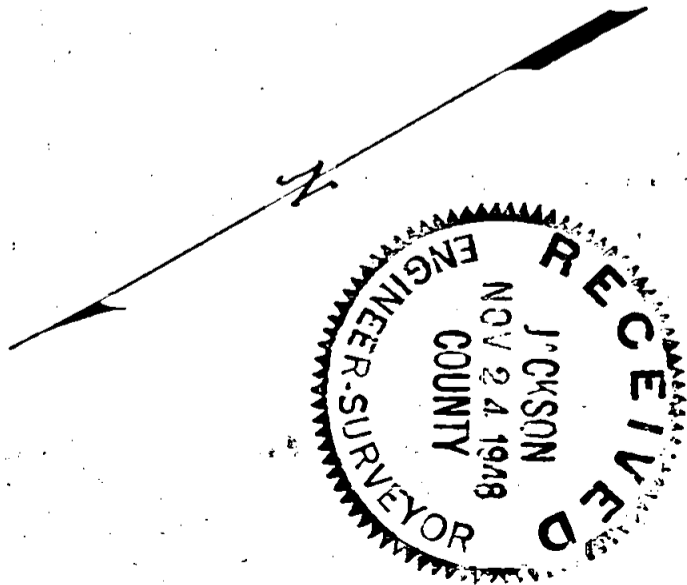
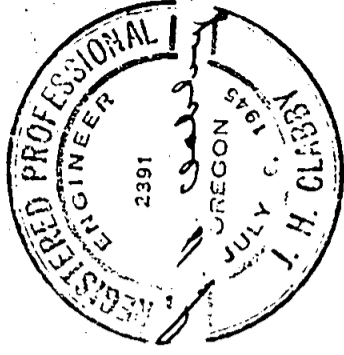

Survey Procedure: Starting at the Quarter corner common to Sections 28 and
33 in said township and range (Corner not re-established
found one B.T. alive and standing. One B. T. down, badly
decayed), ran traverse South and West to center line of
Tiller-Trail Highway, thence along said Highway and along
the center line of Trail Creek as shown on the attached
plat. Bearings derived from solar observations.
