

Survey No. 154

For: Gladys L. Parker

Purpose of Survey: To establish the boundaries of a portion of Block No. 62 of the Original Town of Central Point, as described. Also Lot No. 5, Block No. 6 of Oak Park Addition. Then divide the tract into two lots as directed.

Established the intersection of 2nd Street with Maple Street from existing street monuments.

Then established the 20.0 foot alley in said Block No. 62 at an equal and proportionate distance between Maple and Cherry Streets and ran it parallel to Maple Street.

Established property frontages on Maple Street by a proportion of record distances to measured distances. Then ran the lot lines from Maple Street to the Southerly boundary of the said alley and parallel to 2nd Street.

Courses and distances of the boundaries of tracts surveyed are as shown on the map to accompany this report.

Iron pipes stamped with a No. "7" were set for corners as shown on said map.
