



Survey No. 167

For: George Gilman

Purpose: To survey tracts as directed.

Found a 3/4" iron pipe previously set on survey No. 11, Jackson County Survey Records, said pipe being S. 0° 12' W. 268.0 feet and N. 89° 53' W. 320.0 feet from the N.E. corner of D.L.C. No. 59, Township 37 South, Range 2 West. From said pipe ran S. 89° 53' W. 200.0 feet and set a 3/4" pipe for corner. Continued 600.0 feet and set a 3/4" pipe, then continued 600.0 feet setting 3/4" pipes each 100.0 feet; thence S. 0° 12' W. 200.0 and set a 3/4" pipe; then ran S. 89° 53' E. 600.0 feet setting 3/4" pipes each 100.0 feet; continued 600.0 feet and set a 3/4" pipe; continued 200.0 feet and set a 3/4" pipe; then ran N. 0° 12' E. 200.0 to the point of beginning.

Then began at a 3/4" pipe previously set on said survey No. 11, said pipe being S. 0° 12' W. 268.0 feet and N. 89° 53' W. 320.0 feet from the N.E. corner of said D.L.C. No. 59 and ran S. 89° 53' E. 140.0 feet and set a 3/4" pipe; thence S. 0° 12' W. 600.0 feet and set a reference pipe from which the corner in Bear Creek bears S. 0° 12' W. 159.09 feet, from which corner (by calculation); thence N. 30° 22' 45" W. 42.02 feet, N. 51° 11' W. 151.89 feet, and N. 0° 12' E. 100.0 feet to a pipe previously set on said survey No. 11.

All pipes stamped with a No. "7". See map to accompany this report.
