Purpose of Survey: To establish the boundaries of the C.O.P.C.O.
Sub-station Lot in the Town of Rogue River.

Since said Lot is a tract of land 50.0 feet wide parallel and adjacent to the County Road, bounded by Rogue River at the southerly end and a line 275.0 feet from the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad main track at the northerly end, these controls were established as follows:

The Southern Pacific Railroad as located and constructed, the County Road according to the duly recorded deed for said section and Rogue River to the water edge as of this date.

The Lot was then staked and referenced to the corner of Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, as shown on the plat to accompany this report.
