SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 87-330

1947 OREGON STATE LAW

Survey No. 267

For: T. W. Dailey

Purpose of Survey: To survey and monument a strip of land 15.0 feet wide from the T. W. Dailey property located in Section 36, Township 38 South, Range 3 East, to a particular spring.

Procedure: Began at a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin at the Southeast Corner of the said Dailey land and ran on line to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin at the Southwest corner. Said monuments described in Jackson County Deed Records, Volume 218, Page 324. At a point on said South line 71.51 feet from the Southeast Corner ran S. $3^{\circ} 51'$ E. along the center line of the 15.0 foot strip, 119.58 feet; thence S. $10^{\circ} 37'$ W. 86.9 feet to the center of the spring. Monuments were set along the boundaries of the 15.0 foot strip as shown on the map to accompany this report.
