

NARRATIVE REPORT

SURVEY of PORTION

SECTION 10, T. 36 S, R. 1 EAST of W. M.

JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON

The purpose of the survey was for establishing boundaries for making description of boundaries of the land North of the County Road and determination of method of subdivision for private transfers.

A stake in mound of rock was found on the North fence line and distance and bearing from original bearing tree to Northeast corresponding to original government notes identified it as the North \$\frac{1}{4}\$ corner of Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 1 East of Willamette Meridian. Bearing was established by Polaris observation on Eastern Elongation with 2nd observation to check. Line was run West along fence line to County Road and extended to position of Northwest corner of Section 10 and checked with position indicated by land owner there for the corner, but none was found as some gravel operations have destroyed evidence in the small slough there. Fence line corresponded generally but was irregular alignment.

Carried traverse Easterly from intersection of section line of the County Road 30 feet North of center line and parallel with the center line. Thence Northeasterly along fence line which was designated, and following record description to point determined by record Donation Land Claim notes of Donation Land Claim No. 41, together with U. S. Land Office section notes, to position of Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 41, thence West along the North line of the Claim and South line of Government Lot 2, a distance of 1320 feet, thence North to the Point of Beginning.

Subdivision was then made and corners of parcels were established in accordance with wishes of the owner after preliminary studies.
