

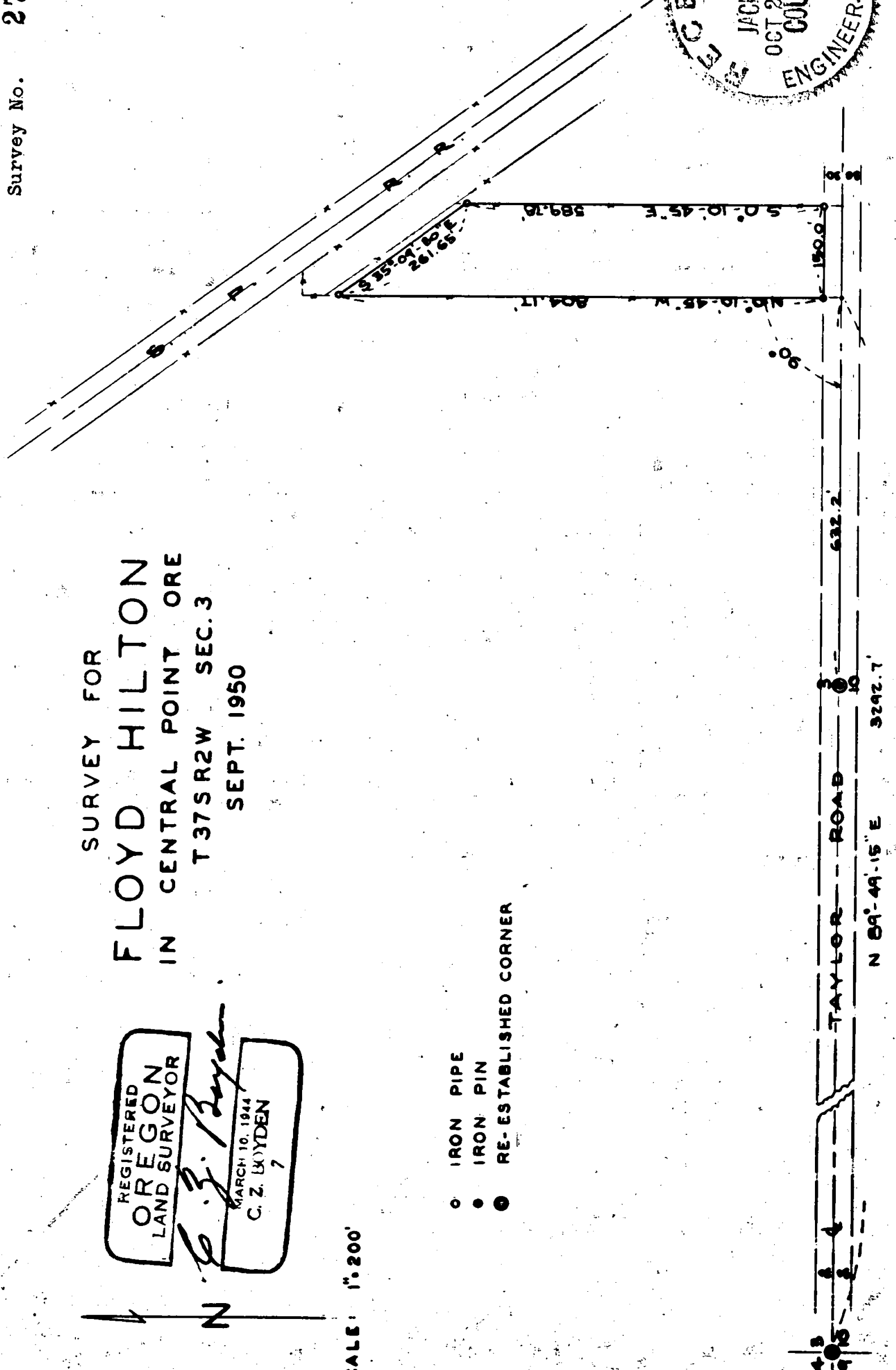
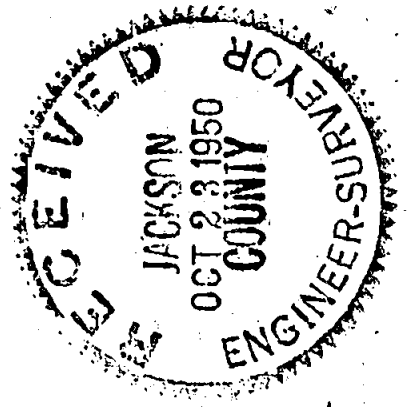

Survey Narrative to comply with Section 87-330 Oregon State Law 1947

Survey No. 274

For: Floyd R. Hilton et ux

Purpose: To establish and monument the property lines described in Jackson County Deed Record Volume 241, Page 101, located in the City of Central Point--Section 3, Township 37 South, Range 2 West.

Procedure: Using the re-established corner to sections 3, 4, 9, and 10, and the proportioned south $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of section 3 for control, ran the record distance of said deed record, 3292.7 feet along the South Boundary of Section 3 for the point of beginning:

Thence ran at right angles to the section line a record distance of 834.17 feet for the west line of said deed record (241-101);

Thence ran S 35° 09' 30" E parallel to the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to a point 150.00 feet at right angle distance from the said west line;

Thence ran the east line S 0° 10' 45" E parallel to the west line to an intersection with said section line;

Thence ran the record distance of 150.00 feet S 89° 49' 15" W along the section line to the point of beginning.

Excepted the South 30.0 feet from said property as said strip falls in Taylor Road.
