PROPERTY SITUATE IN



Purpose of Survey:

To plot property boundary.

Commencing at the northwest corner of D.L.C.Nc. 90, Township 37

South, Ramge 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, said corner being a pipe, ran thence east 3044.6 feet along the north line of D.I.C.No. 90 to an existing iron pipe which is indicated on a plat, dated May 1949, filed by S.
