No. 45 and ran S 89° 59' 30" W along the D.L.C. line a distance of 735.64 feet, then ran N 26°29' 30" W 33.52 feet to th3 point of beginning of deed 305-104 then turned to S 89° 59' 30" W and ran deed distance of 37.52 feet and set a 5/8" x 30" iron bar for corner.
