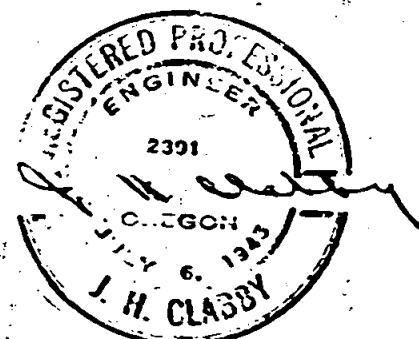
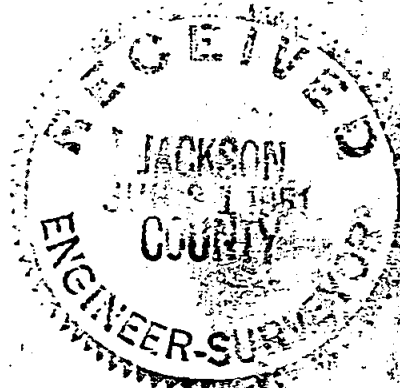


BOUNDARY LOCATION

Survey Narrative to Comply with Sec. 87-330, 1947 Oregon State Laws.

Survey for: Edward Niles
Southeast Quarter Section 14, Township 37 South, Range 2 West,
Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose of Survey:

To segregate a parcel of land from original tract.

Survey Procedure:

Found 1" iron pipes on easterly property line which were set
by S.C. Watkins, a Registered Professional Engineer. From
these points staked a strip of land 40 feet wide by 200
feet on South and 179.21 feet on north, fronting on U. S.
Highway No. 99.

Ran line to southeast corner of D.L.C. No. 62, said Township and
Range using record bearings and described the parcel of land
accordingly.
