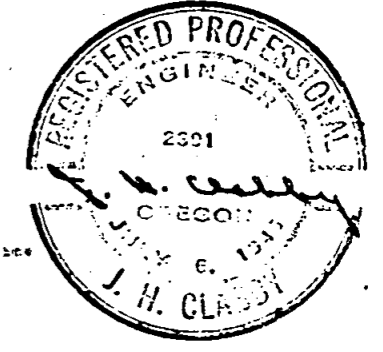


BOUNDARY LOCATION

Survey Narrative to Comply with Section 87-330, 1947 Oregon State Laws.

Survey for: Pete Batemen

Location: Garden Acres, D.L.C. 59, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose of Survey:

To locate a triangular parcel of land.

Procedure: Found iron pin at the northeast corner of Lot 11 and the Southeast corner Lot 12. Projected line northerly to a fence corner designated as the south boundary. Chained distance (northeast Lot 11 to fence) 594.06 feet. Ran traverse easterly along fence line to Bear Creek. Also ran traverse northerly to a point in vicinity of Southeast corner of Lot 3 located said southeast corner.
