SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 87-330,  
1947 OREGON STATE LAW

Survey No. 429

For: O. Hamilton and M. E. Lamb

Purpose of Survey: To establish the boundaries of two tracts  
of land to be exchanged.

Procedure: Established the west boundary of D.L.C. No. 55  
between the officially re-established southwest corner and the  
westerly ELL corner, then established the corners of the Hamilton  
and Lamb properties on this D.L.C. line according to their  
officially recorded deeds; then determined the location of the  
street along the Northeasterly boundary of Pattison Addition to  
Central Point from the old stakes found along the boundary of  
said addition.

From the above mentioned controls staked the boundaries of  
the tracts as shown on the map to accompany this report.

A comparison of the record descriptions of the properties  
indicates a gap between the two of one link along Hamilton's  
north line.
