

Survey Narrative to Comply with Section 87-330, Oregon State Law, 1947.

Survey No. 475

For: Southern Oregon Title Co., Property located in Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 2 West.

Purpose: To establish the boundaries a tract of land as directed and prepare a description of same.

Established the location of Kirtland road by replacing points on record angles and distances from the P.I. at Engineers' station 23 + 77.7 to station 0 + 00. Then projected the tangent from station 6 + 72.2 thru station 0 + 00 to an intersection with the section line between sections 20 and 29 for a tie to the SE corner of Section 20.

Established the south boundary of the Southern Pacific Company property for the Tolo to White City Railroad by intersecting the west boundary of Kirtland road with a line from the iron pipe reported to be at the S.W. Corner of Lat "F" of the Whiting tract thru the south reference point for the point of curve, which point was found to be 25.0 southerly from the engineers centerline as monumented. Then established and monumented the required tract being 208.0 feet on four sides and bounded by the said Southern Pacific Company property on the north and the west boundary of Kirtland Road on the east.
