

Survey Narrative to Comply with Section 87-330 Oregon State  
Law, 1947

For: D. W. Howell and W. C. Byers.

Located: In the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11, Township  
35 South, Range 4 West.

Purpose: To survey, monument and describe two tracts as  
directed.

Procedure: Began at the recognized center of Section 11, an  
old stone with cross on top set by County Surveyor G. Elksnat  
over 40 years ago at which time he subdivided said section No.  
11. Then established the line between this stone and the  
officially re-established  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between Sections 10 and 11.  
Since weather conditions did not permit an observation for  
meridian, determination this line was called East and West and  
the East and West boundaries of the tracts were turned off 90°  
00" to this line. The Southerly boundary of the tracts was the  
center of Vrooman Ditch. Pipe monuments were set as shown on the  
map to accompany this report.
