

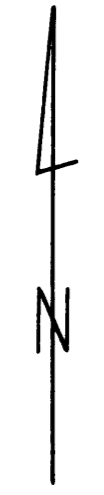

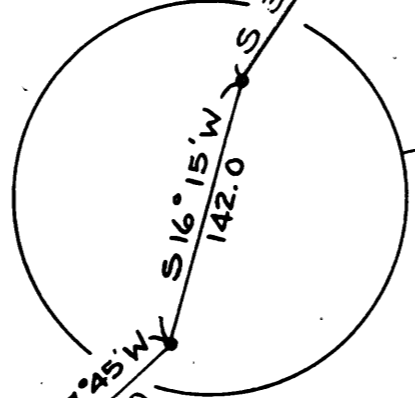

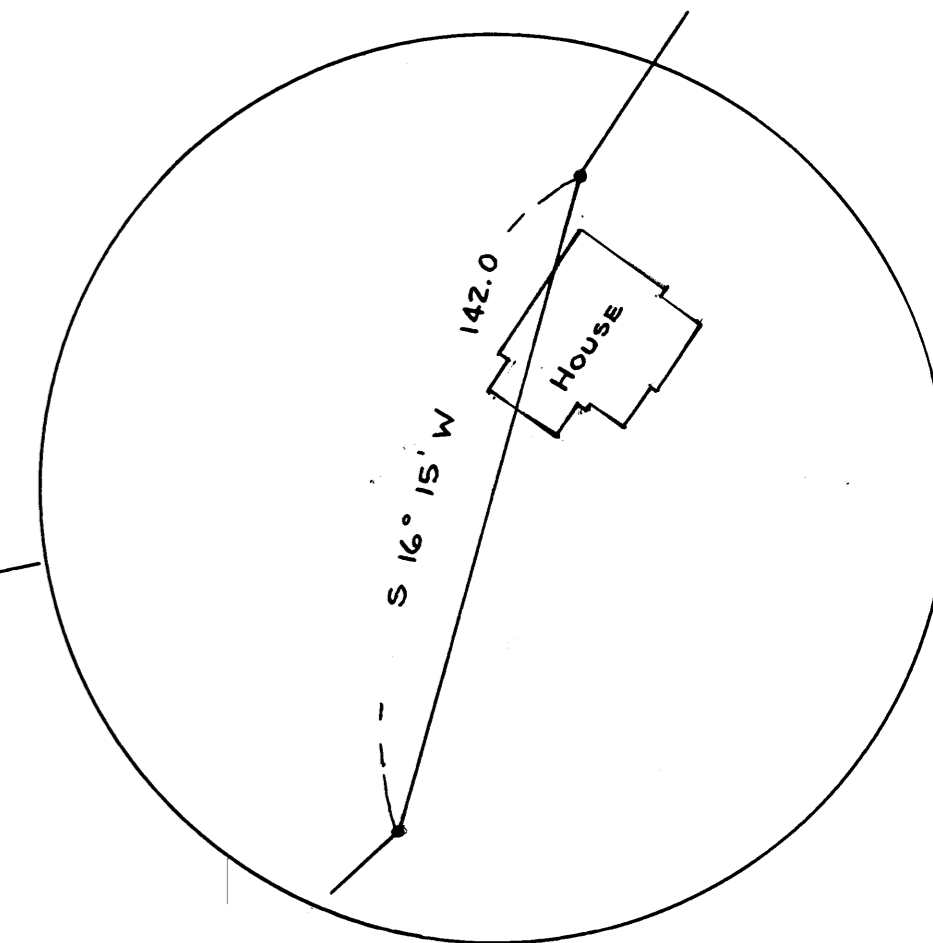

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 87-330 OREGON STATE LAW, 1947.

SURVEY NUMBER 528

SURVEY FOR: L. H. Valentine

PURPOSE: To survey and monument that division line between the Wolf and Sterling Mines, Inc. property in the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 39, South Range 2, West, and described in Jackson County Deed Records Volume 312 Page 64.

PROCEDURE:

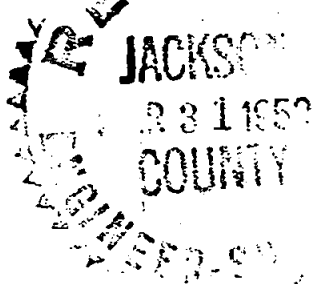
Ran random lines connecting the SW corner, and the S  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner; the S  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, and the N  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner; the W  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner and the E  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 8.

Set an iron pipe at the N  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner from the legible scribe found in the shell of the NW W. Oak B.T. For reference of the other corners found, see the Re-established corner records in the County Surveyor's Office.

From these random lines, computed and set the Center  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, and the Center South 1/16 th Section corner of Section 8, and the West 1/16 th Section corner between Sections 8 and 17.

The present deeds for the Sterling Mines and the Wolf properties indicate differences in two of the courses in the partition line between said properties; however, the Wolf deed is identical to the original partition deed of 1919, and was the described line monumented in this survey, with the exception of the closing course into the W 1/16 th Section corner.

This closing course, being described as a more or less distance, was closed according to the present survey, as shown on the attached map.

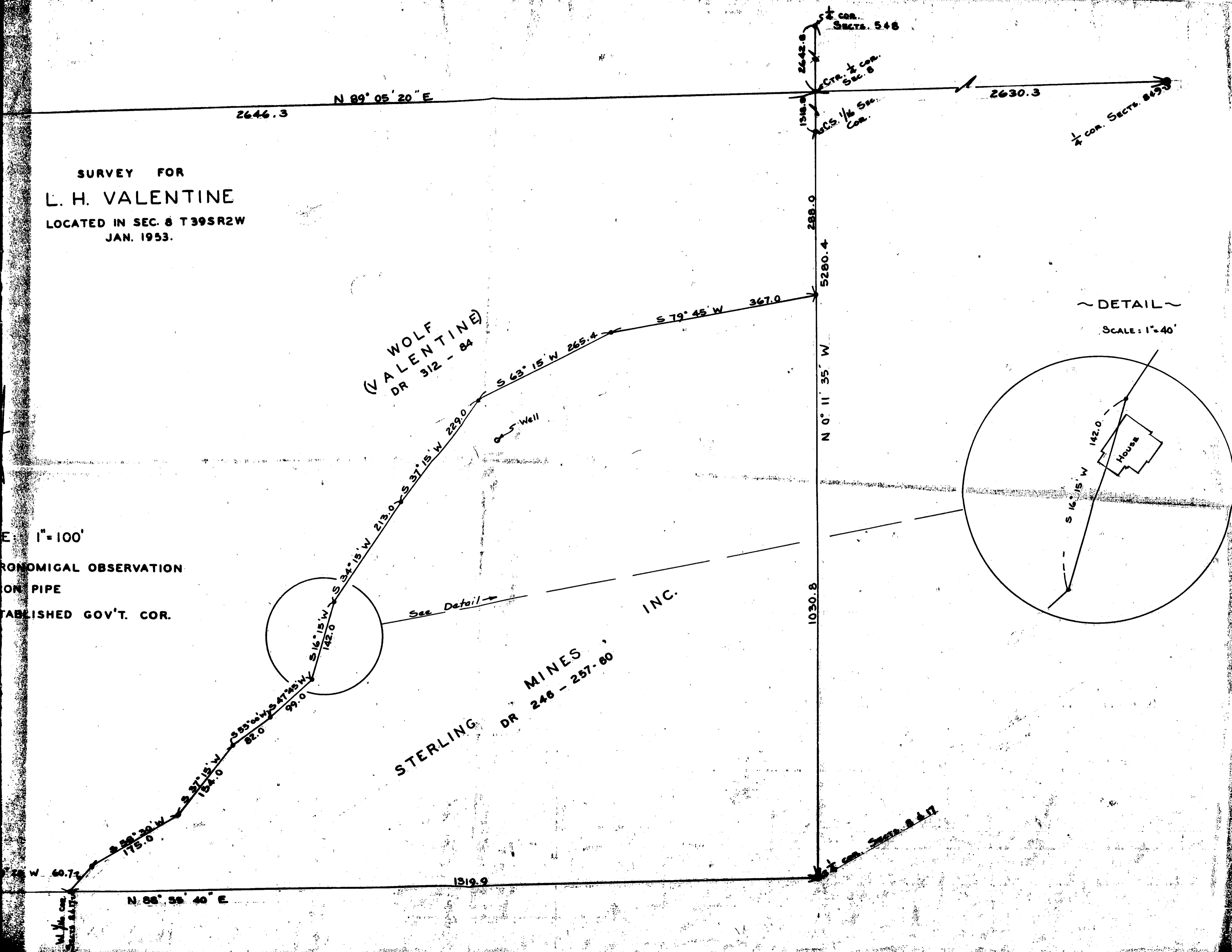

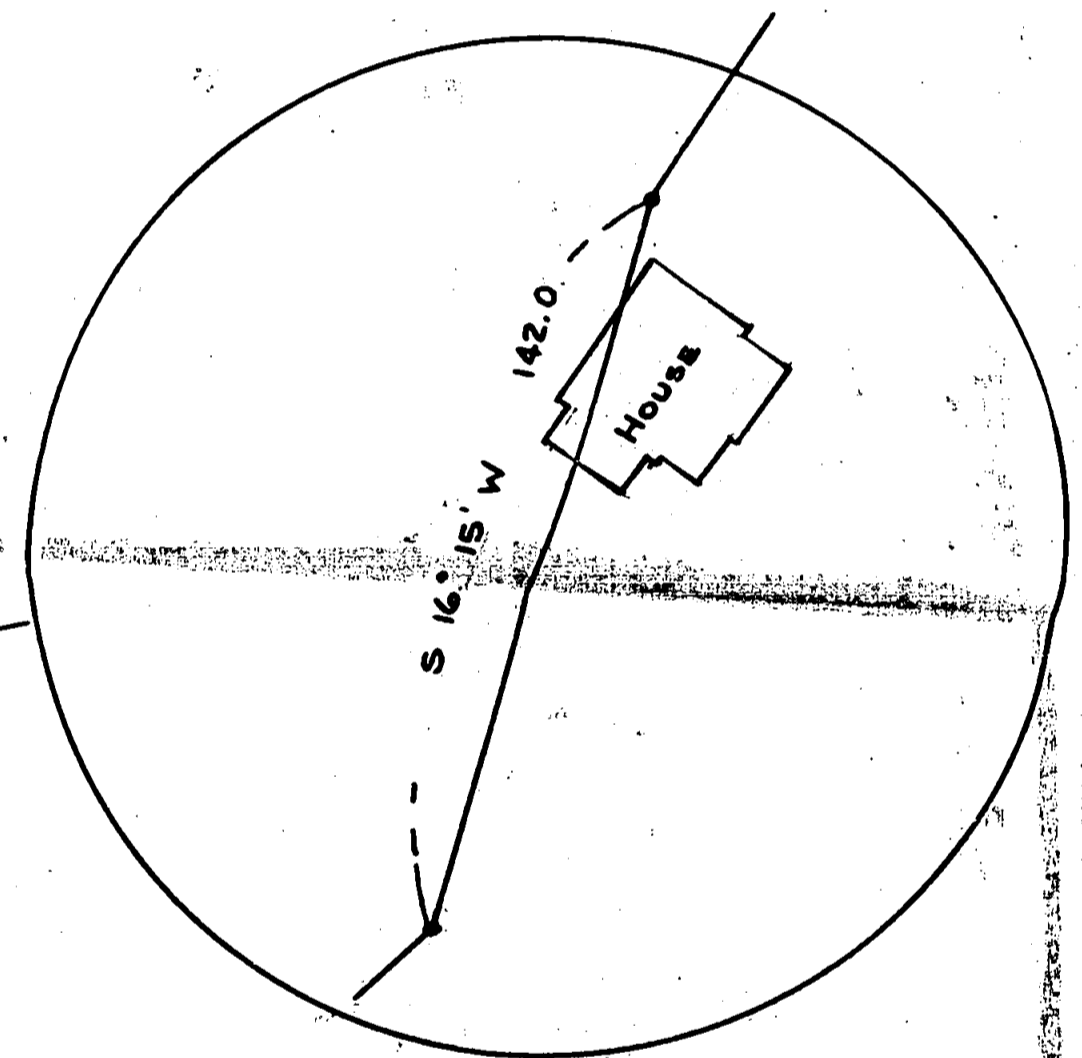
