Survey Narrative to Comply with Section 87-330 Oregon State
Law (1947)

Survey For: WILLIAM E. BROOKS

Purpose: To locate the outside boundary of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4
and 7 of Army Subdivision of Lots 3, 5 and 6, Block 1 of
Jackson's Addition to the City of Medford.

Procedure:

Found iron monuments around the perimeter of
Army Subdivision with corresponding distances
and courses shown on the attached map.

Used said monuments as found, excepting those
fronting E. Main Street where the lot lines were
extended Northerly to intersect the South Boundary
of said Main Street 30.00 feet South of the
North Boundary of D.L.C. No. #44, where lead
plugs were set in the concrete sidewalk for
true property corners.
