Proceedure; The boundary of this parcel I had previously surveyed and staked for Mr. Clarence Dodge on October 1953.

I began atvihe seuthwest corner of Dedge tract, a 3/4" pipe set in concrete at the base of a concrete retaining wall and ran N25°36'W 75.00 feet along the easterly line of the Old Pacific Highway and set a 5/8" x 30" iron Bar. I then set instrument on this last point and turned parallel to the south line of the tract and set a pair of straddle hubs across the westerly right of way line of the Relocated Pacific Highway, I then occupied the P.S.C. Sta 212+92.7 and taking the chord distance from the string intersection to this P.S.C. I computed the angle for that part of the offset spiral and on that angle intersected the string and drove a 5/8" x 30" iron bar to mark the corner (southeasterly) of this Shell Oil Co. Lease.
