
## MT. PITT CO. BY ORDER OF, BOB COLLINS AMY HARBAUGH'S ADD. TO CENTRAL POINT BOYDEN & BOYDEN APR. 1954



Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes.

For: Mt. Pitt Company

Purpose: To survey the Mt. Pitt Company property, being Lot No. 1 and an adjacent portion of that excluded tract within Block No. 7 of Amy Harbaugh's Addition to Central Point.

Procedure: Although the recorded plat of said Addition shows Lot No. 1 as being 29.66 feet wide, deeds prior to and after the platting of said Subdivision call this distance 29-1/3 feet. Since said Lot No. 1 has been made a part of a larger tract, including land Southeasterly, this error falls within the boundaries of said tract.

Since the City Street monument control was not continued Westerly of the railroad, said Block No. 7 was enclosed by projecting the monumented centerlines of Pine and Manzanita Streets Westerly and establishing Haskell Street and the alley (now Amy Street) a record distance Westerly from the centerline of the S. P. Railroad right-of-way.

The boundaries of the tract surveyed were monumented to include the Southerly 20.0 feet of Manzanita Street, now vacated and to exclude a strip 23.5 feet wide along Amy Street to be deeded to the City, said strip having been occupied as a portion of Amy Street.

Iron pins were set for corners as shown on the map to accompany this report.
