

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250, Oregon Revised
Statutes

Survey For: MEDFORD PEAR COMPANY

Location: Sections 3 and 4, Township 38 South, Range 1 West.

Purpose: to monument the boundaries of the properties described in Jackson County Deed Records, Volume 359, Page 48.

Procedure:

A study of the property descriptions, past and present, indicated that the intention was to convey an over all tract, bounded on the North by the Township line, on the East by the D.L.C. line (now the centerline of the North Phoenix Market Road), on the South by the South line of D.L.C. No. 38, and on the West by a described line being a specified distance West from the East boundary of D.L.C. No. 38.

It is noted that tract "C" lacked 35.9 feet of running as far West as Tracts "A" and "B" thus leaving a strip between the West line of Tract "C" and the 30.0 foot right-of-way being a part of Tract "B".

The North line of D.L.C. No. 40 and the South line of D.L.C.

No. 38 from the Northeast corner of D.L.C. #40 to the Southeast

corner of D.L.C. No. 38 were established and iron pin monuments set

for the Southwest corner of Tract "C" and the South cornersof said 30.00 **

foot right-of-way.

The North line of Section 4 was established and an iron pin set on this line for the Northwest corner of tract "A". Then from said point a line ran South 0° 06' West parallel to the East Corner of said tracts 1186.22 feet to the record Southwest remove of Section 11 1954 width of Tract "B", said distance being equal to the South tie plus the WUNTY width of Tract "B."
