

Survey Narrative to Comply with Section 87-330, 1947 Oregon Law.

Survey for: William Mooney

Location: Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose of survey:

To survey and divide a parcel of land recorded under Deed Record 313-21.

Procedure:

Found quarter corner common to Sections 29 and 32 and the northeast corner Section 32. Located the northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 32 at a point on section line and 1325.96 feet west of said Northeast corner of Section 32. Continued west 445.50 feet for the true point of beginning, thence South 404.25 feet, thence west 214.50 feet, thence North 404.25 feet, thence East 214.50 feet to the point of beginning.

Pipe monuments were also set at the intermediate points on east and west boundary lines.

Fences on the east and west are some 6 feet rest of the lines established by survey. The south fence is 6 feet south of the survey.

The owner was advised that a comprehensive survey of his property will entail the subdivision of Section 32 which, for the most, part lies in difficult terrain. He was further advised that future surveys may change the bearings for the east and west lines.
