

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes.

Survey For: Emmett Cantrall

Purpose: To monument the outside boundary of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 24, Original town (now city) of Medford, Oregon.

Procedure: Used the existing street centerline monuments as shown on the attached map, cutting in the centers on Third Street at Front and Central from Street controls previously used by this office. Enclosed Block 24 by angles and distances on the street centerlines and proportioned the property corners accordingly.

At the Northeasterly property corner, found $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin.

To further perpetuate the East corners fronting North Central Avenue, lead plugs were set in the concrete sidewalk on the Northerly and Southerly boundaries of said property extended Easterly 1.00 foot.
