Survey Narrative to comply with Paragraph 209.250, Oregon Revised Statutes

SURVEY FOR: Kogap Lumber Industries, an Oregon corporation.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a parcel located in Sections 31 and 32, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian.

PROCEDURE: In a comprehensive survey made by this office in 1929-1930, the Southeast corner of D.L.C. #45; the Northwest corner D.L.C. #46 (on the East boundary of D.L.C. #45); the Southerly boundary of RENSHAW SUBDIVISION and the BUTLER TRACTS in D.L.C. #45 as they are now described were monumented.


Found all of the control monuments with the exception of the pipe monument at the Northwest corner of the property to be described. Replaced said corner on the monumented North boundary of the subject property and record distance Westerly from the North, Northeast corner of the subject property; then established the Westerly boundary of the subject property using record angles and distances Southerly from the Northwest property corner and closing the last course to the $l\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe found.

Monuments used and set are denoted on the attached map with meridian derived from the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad mainline.
