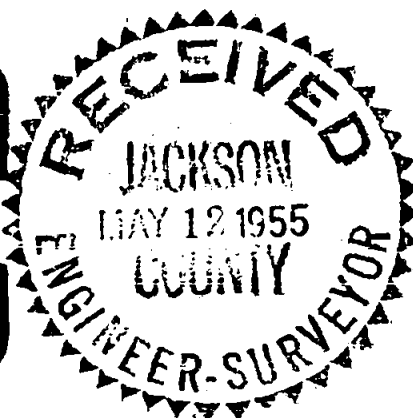

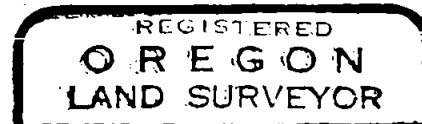
Written narrative to accompany plat for Survey No. _____
as specified by Oregon Law.

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Date April 30, 1955.

Purpose to stake out metes and bounds property on Oak Street

Procedure, As this deed read "Commencing at the most Easterly Southeast corner of Mary's Place Addition, thence East 34.40 feet to the east line of Oak Street, Thence North 50.0 feet to the point of beginning, thence continuing North along said street line 100.0 feet, thence East 104.86 feet; thence south 100.0 feet to a point East of the point of beginning, thence West 104.86 feet to the point of beginning; I had the concrete monument at the Most easterly southeast corner of Marys Place Add. and the monument at Jackson And Oak Street, I then ran the survey as specified above.
