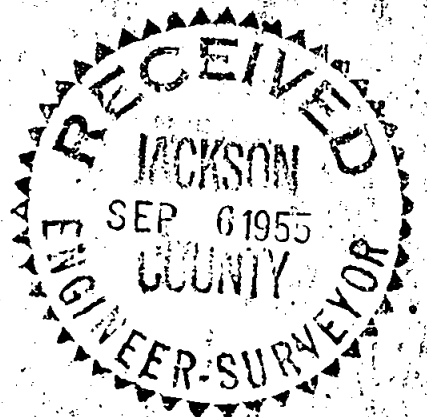
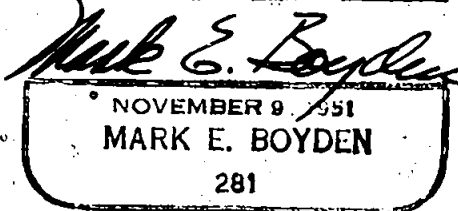
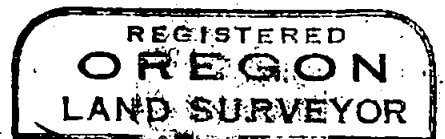
FOR: James H. Grieve

PURPOSE: To survey and monument the boundaries of two tracts as directed by Mr. Grieve. Said tracts located in the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 29, Township 32 South, Range 3 East.

PROCEDURE: The local office of the State Highway Department was unable to furnish any information for a monumented centerline control for this section of the Crater Lake Highway. However, the plat of the "Prospect Tracts" indicated monuments set along the boundaries of said highway. These monuments were recovered and a centerline established from them was used for this survey.

The required tracts were then surveyed and monumented and a tie was made to the South 1/4 corner of Section 29. The tie as shown is grid and was calculated from a meridian by solar observation.
