BASIS OF BEARING:

Surveys of record which complies with O.S.L.

Sec. 2, T. 37S., R. 2 W.

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Found stone on surface at NW corner DLC 56 being a point on the center line of Freeman Road extended, also found concrete monument 6 inches below surface as shown, and 5/8 inch Iron pin on Section line between Sections 2 and 11.

Determined the North line deeds of record Vol. 373 page 229 and also South line County road in deed Vol. 282 page 147, using record angle $81^{\circ}53'10''$; thence proceeded as shown on map, setting a 3/4 inch Iron bolt as the most South east corner, a 1/2 inch Iron pin as the South west corner and points set being 3/4 inch Iron pipes.
