

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250,
Oregon Revised Statutes

FOR: Keith Lawton

PURPOSE: To monument the Southerly 58 feet of Lots 5 and 6,
Block 31 in the original town (now City) of Central
Point, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Found the centerline control for Cedar Street from
those monuments used on record survey No. 433. Also found the
copper rivet set in the concrete pavement as set by this office
for the intersection of the South boundary of Ash Street with
the centerline of Fourth Street. From these controls, turned
the angle at Fourth and Cedar, chained the centerline distance
on Cedar from Fourth to Fifth Street, proportioning the easterly
tract boundary as shown on the attached map.
