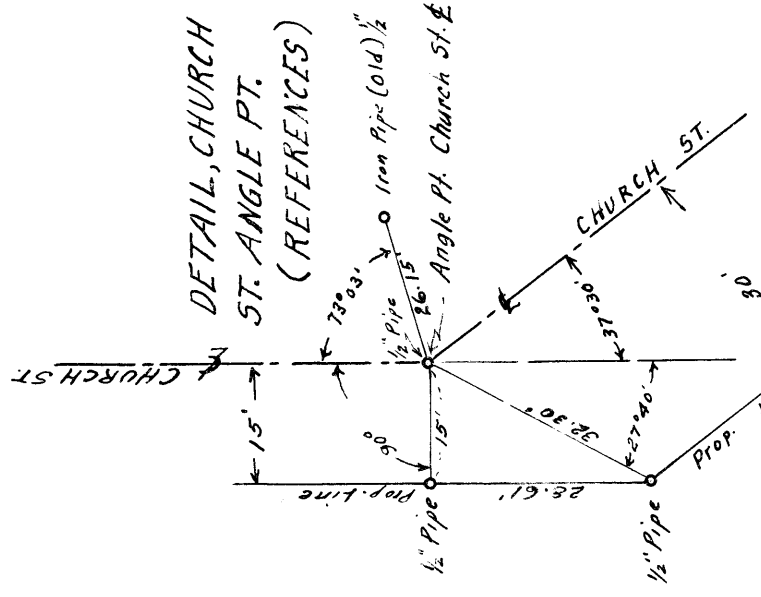
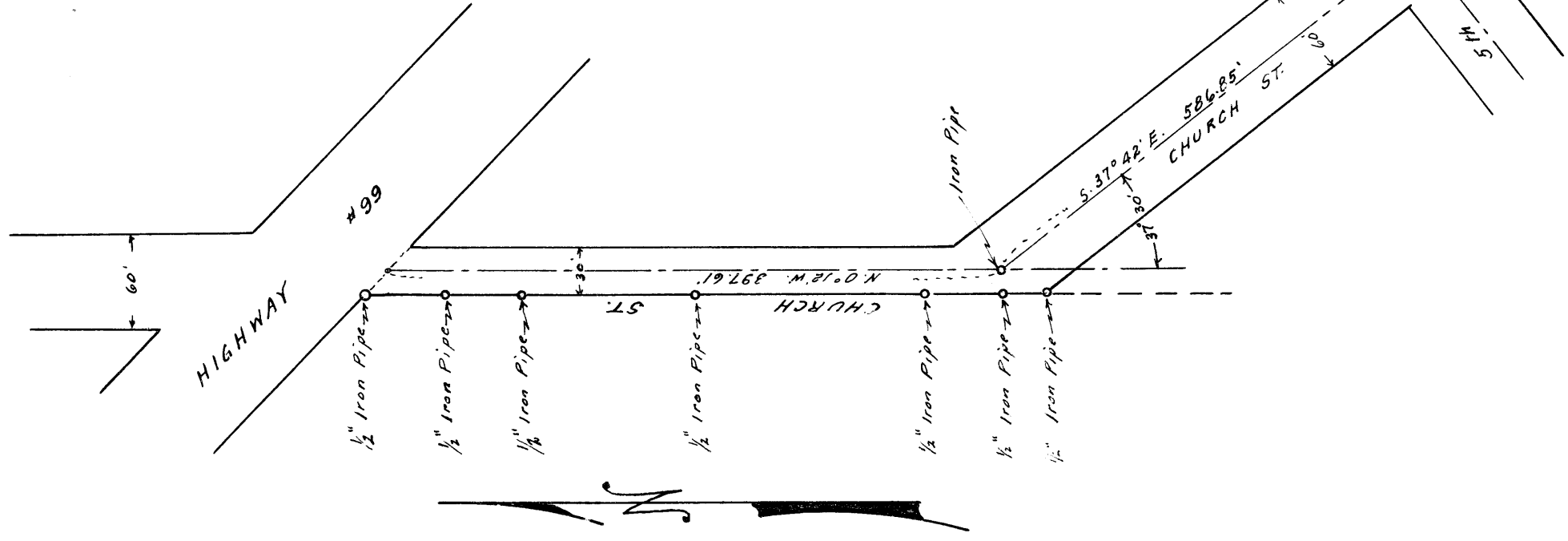

Spike of Church & 5th Sts.

Survey narrative to comply with Section 87-330 Oregon State Law of 1947.

For: City of Phoenix, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose: To mark with iron pipes set at intervals along the West line of Church Street marking the West line thereof.

Procedure: From property corners along the East line of Church Street (the N-S- portion) I measured and set points westerly 15 feet from and at right angles to the property line to establish the center-line of this portion of Street. Having established this line I began at a spike set at the intersection of the center-line of the southeasterly portion of Church Street with the center-line of 5th Street, turning the record angle from the center-line of 5th Street to the center-line of the southeasterly portion of Church Street, and produced this line to an intersection with the center-line previously established on the N.-S. portion of Church Street at which point of intersection I set a 1/2 inch iron pipe and referenced same, according to detail shown on accompanying map. Iron pipes have been set for the street boundaries accordingly as shown on map.
