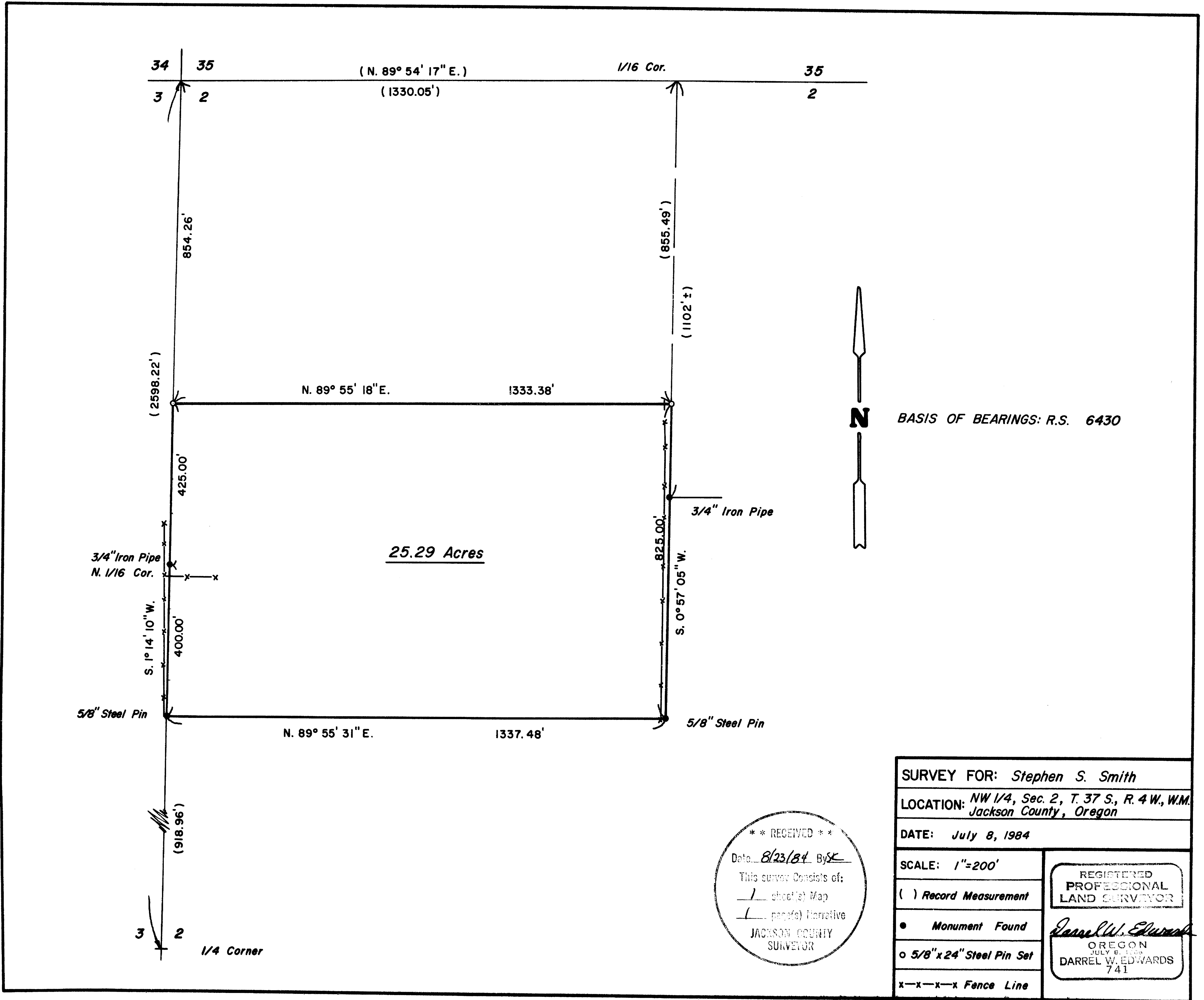

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES.

SURVEY FOR: Stephen S. Smith
1696 Foots Cr. Rd.
Gold Hill, Or. 97525

LOCATION: In the NW 1/4 of Section 2, T. 37 S., R. 4 W., W.M. in Jackson
County, Oregon.

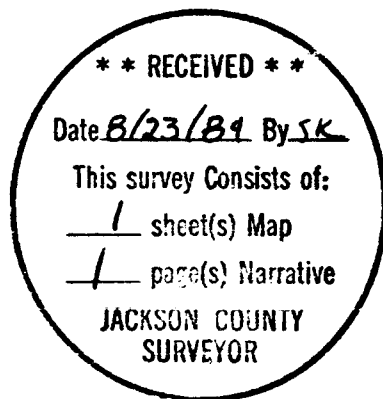
PURPOSE: To locate and monument the North Line of the Smith property
and to place points along the East and West property lines.

PROCEDURE: Beginning at the 5/8" iron rod at the SW Corner of the parcel,
I run a random traverse near the West, North and East boundary
lines of the subject property tying to the monuments set at the
North 1/16 Corner and the SE Corner of the subject property in
R.S. 6430. Using R.S. 6430 as a basis of bearings, I calculate
this traverse and the bearings and distances between monuments
and find that I agree very closely with R.S. 6430. I accept
these monuments and offset points to the property lines and set
5/8" x 2 1/2" steel pins with plastic caps stamped "DW EDWARDS-LS
741" at the NW and NE property corners as shown on the accomp-
anying plat.
