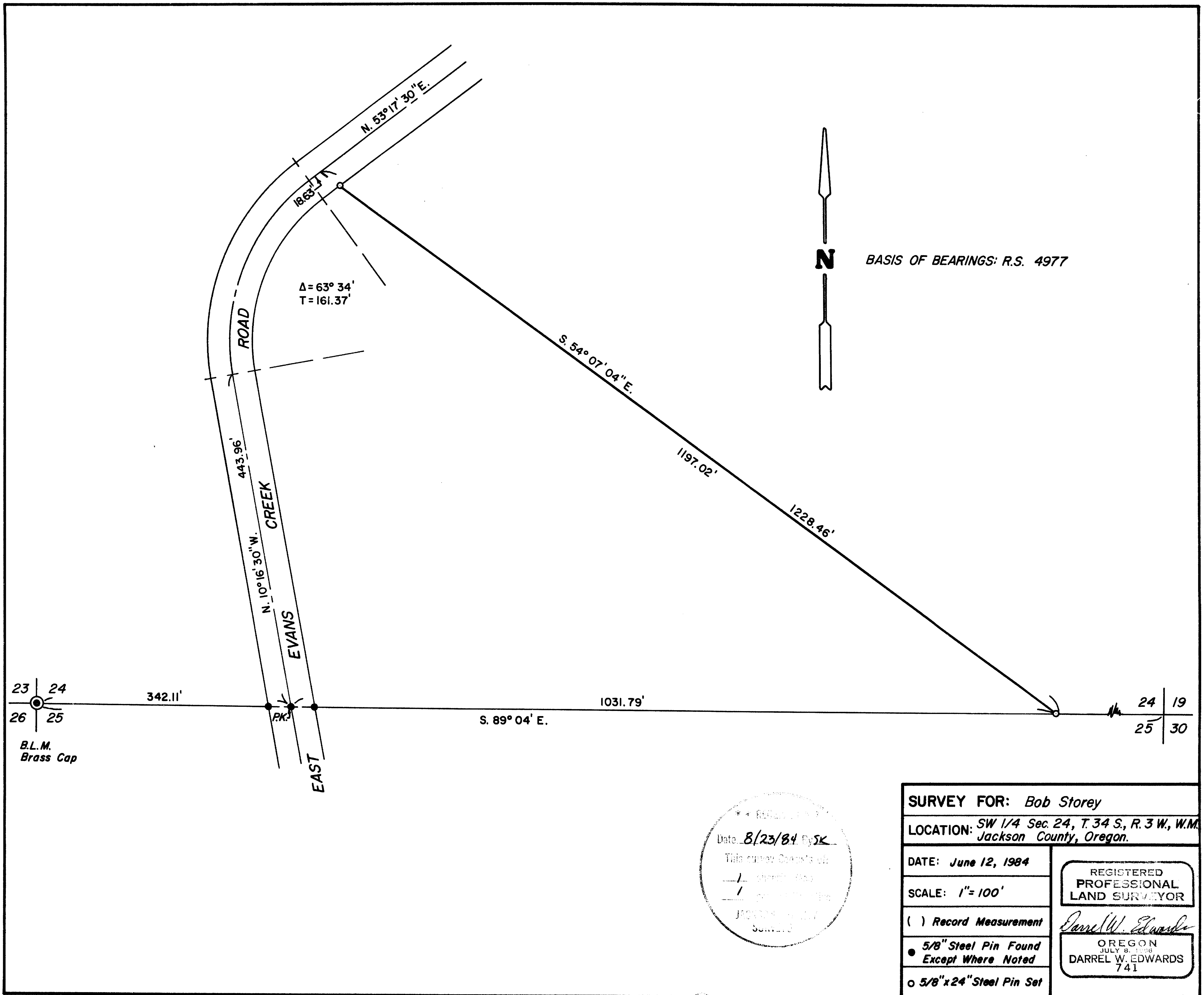

Jackson County, Oregon.

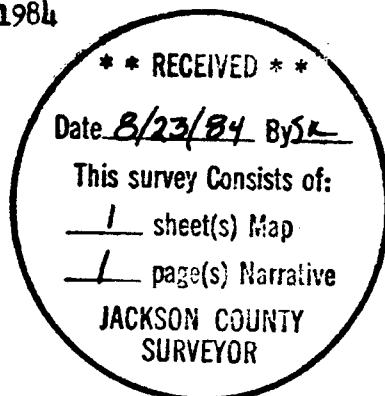
PURPOSE: To locate and monument a property line as per a description
provided by Mr. Storey.

PROCEDURE: I had established control on the center line of E. Evans Cr. Rd.
during R.S. 4977. I was able to re-locate the 5/8" steel pins
and the P.K. nail on the South Line of Section 24. Using these
points and the B.L.M. brass cap at the SW Sec. Cor., I retrace
R.S. 4977 and establish the boundary line per the clients'
description. At the property corners I set 5/8" x 24" steel pins
with plastic caps stamped "DW EDWARDS-LS 741" as shown on the
accompanying plat.
