PURPOSE: To survey and monument a lot line adjustment in a major land partition situated in the SE1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 3, T37S, RAW, W.M., Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Rejugan at the NW 1/16 corner of said Section 3 which is monumented with a one inch dia. iron pipe set per CS No. 2662 from which bears;

A Fruit Tree, 20 inches dia., S 282°W, 26.7 feet.

Thence I traversed S89°34'04"E, 1331.52 feet to the CN 1/16 corner of said Section 3 which is monumented with a one inch dia. iron pipe set per C.S. No. 2662 from which bears;

A White Oak, 16 inch dia., N64°E, 126.7 feet. A White Oak, 10 inch dia., S52°E, 157.7 feet.

Thence I traversed S0°42'41"W, 1316.25 feet to the Center 1/4 corner of said Section 3 which is monumented with a 1½ inch iron pipe set per C.S. No. 2662 from which bears;

A Douglas Fir, 30 inch dia., S54°B, 13.9 feet.

A Douglas Fir, 10 inch dia., S32°W, 23.8 feet.

A Doulgas Fir, 12 inch dia., N77°W, 19.1 feet.

Thence I traversed N89°48'42"W, 1327.55 feet to the CW 1/16 corner of said Section 3 which is monumented with a one inch dia. iron pipe per C.S. No. 2662 from which bears:

A Doulgas Fir, 16 inch dia., 877°E, 35.6 feet.

Thence I found iron monuments as shown on the Plat and set 5/8"X30" iron rods as shown on Plat.

A Wild T-16 Theodolite and a MAC 1E E.D.M. was used to execute this survey.

Meridian is based on C.S. No. 6606.
