


Right-of-way monumentation established on Filed Survey No. 4258 was produced Northeasterly as shown.

BASIS OF BEARINGS: Filed Survey No. 7181

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe parcel No.1 of a partition of T.L. 1100,

34-1W-15 approved by the Shady Cove Planning Commission on August 7,

1984.

PROCEDURE:

The 2" galv. iron pipe with 2 1/2 br. cap set by county surveyor personel for the Southwest corner of section 15 and other controling monuments indicated as found on the annexed map were tied utilizing a one-second theodolite and E.D.M. equipment. The found 3/4" galv. iron pipes have been driven over the 5/8" iron pins set on Filed Survey No. 7181. The origin of the 3/4" black iron pipe found for the Northeast corner of that tract described in Inst. No. 78-15832 O.R. 1\$ unknown.

The Oregon State Highway Department is planning a reconstruction of the Crater Lake Highway in the not to distant future. At that time they will be establishing a right-of-way center line and acquiring deeds for their right-of-way. I was advised by Highway Department Engineering personel to use local survey monumentation until this right-of-way acquistion is accomplished.
