## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Northwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 28 and Northeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 29, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument, and describe the boundary of the tract of land as shown on the attached map. Also, to prepare the necessary legal descriptions to comply with the conditions of approval as outlined in File No. 84-59-LLA, Dept. of Planning and Development, Jackson County.

PROCEDURE: Using monuments which were either found or set per Survey No.'s 262, 1941, 3939, and 5124, established the boundaries of the subject tract as shown. The West line of that portion of the subject tract which is determined by the tract of land described in Volume 342, page 210 of the Deed Records was monumented at the record distance of 490.00 feet "East" of the found 1-1/2 inch iron pipe as reset in Survey No. 3939. From the monumented deed corner, ran a record bearing of "South" to intersect the approximate South line of Donation Land Claim No. 38. This approximate D.L.C. line was determined by projecting the bearing between two monuments set for Survey No. 5124 (as a proposed boundary line agreement line) to the East as shown on the map. This line falls approximately two feet South of the existing power lines which is consistent with a map found at Pacific Power and Light office which shows the power poles were placed two feet North of an existing fence line in 1940. This is also consistent with the right of way easement for power lines granted in Volume 225, page 492 and an overhang easement granted in Volume 228, page 262. The East line of the tract described in Volume 342, page 210 was determined from found monuments as shown. The most Easterly East line of the subject tract was determined by projecting a line South and North from a found monument which line is the West line of the tract described in Volume 133, page 617 of the Deed Records. This line projected North across Niedermeyer Creek falls 2.9 feet West of a green metal fence post which Dick Niedermeyer reported that his father had placed there many years ago to mark the North-South property line. Also, projecting this monumented line North approximately 1500 feet North of Niedermeyer Creek to an existing East-West fence line would intersect said fence line 2.1 feet West of a stake Dick Niedermeyer set as the old fence corner as best he could remember. The Northerly and Westerly boundary of the subject tract was determined by the average meanderings of Niedermyer Creek and the Easterly boundary of the Medford Irrigation District Canal as located per Survey No. 3939. The following measurement data are for the aforementioned boundaries:
