SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE STATE OF OREGON County of Jackson I, John Hardey, duly Registered Surveyor of the State of Oregon being duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, as provided by law, the tract of land hereon shown and that the plat is a correct representation of same and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines: Commencing at a 2 inch galvanized pipe, said pipe being the Initial Point to the HI-LAND ADDITION to Talent, Jackson County, Oregon, also said pipe bears South 0°17'54" East, 1884.55 feet (record 1885.00 feet) from the Northwest Corner of Donation Land Claim No. 64, Township 38 South, Range I West of the Willamette Meridian; thence South 23°52'20" East, 325.92 feet to a 3 inch bronze disc in concrete stamped "INITIAL POINT-TAYLOR SUBDIVISION", said point being on the south line of that tract of land described in Instrument No. 66-08298 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon for the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 0°21'53" West, 875.61 feet to a point on the north right-of-way of Rapp Road; thence along said right-of-way South 89°53'02" West, 51. 20 feet; thence South 84°39'01" East, 9.03 feet to the southeast corner of that tract of land as described in Instrument No. 77-11095 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; thence North 0°21'53" West, 50.00 feet to a 5/8 iron pin situated at the northeast corner of said tract of land; thence South 84°39'01" West, along the north line of said tract of land 50.00 feet to a point on the east right-of-way of Wagner Creek Road; thence along said right-of-way North 0°21'53" West, 831.12 feet to a point situated on said right-of-way, also being South 89°56'44" West, 10.07 feet from a 5/8 inch iron pin situated at the southwest corner of the aforementioned tract of land described in Instrument No. 66-08298; thence North 89°56'44"East along south line of said tract 10.07 feet to said 5/8 inch iron pin; thence continuing North 89°56'44" East along said south line, 99. 93 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING. SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

LOCATION: Situated in the Northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument the lot corners of the proposed TAYLOR SUBDIVISION.

PROCEDURE: Reviewed existing surveys and deeds in the area. The north line of the proposed subdivision was controlled by recorded survey number 3105 using found monuments. We then researched the county records for control along Wagner Creek Road and Rapp Road and found that both were originally dedicated in 1873 by petition. A survey was done in 1910 along the centerline of both roads with 1/2 inch iron pipes being set at the P.I. points and angle bars being set as reference points along the line. Wagner Creek Road, from its intersection with Rapp Road westerly has been well established by the County, however its alignment to the north has not been reestablished since 1910 (per record data). The east-west alignment of Rapp Road from the intersection of Rapp and Wagner Creek Roads has not been reestablished since the survey of 1910. We searched for the 1910 survey monuments along Rapp and Wagner Creek Roads and found those as indicated on the attached map. We also found a spike set at the intersection Rapp Road and Rapp Lane by the County Road Engineers but it was used only as alignment for Rapp Lane south and was not intended to be used as alignment for Rapp Road (per County Engineers). We then computed the location of a spike that was set at the intersection of Wagner Creek Road and Rapp Road from prior recorded surveys in the area. This spike was also set by the County Road Engineers for alignment of Wagner Creek Road to the west and was not intended to be used for alignment to the north (per County Engineers). The position of this spike did fit very well with prior surveys and evidence of ownership along Wagner Creek road to the north, as far as the "Initial Point of Hi-land Addition to Talent". We held the spike and the previously mentioned "Initial Point" as the centerline of Wagner Creek Road. We then evaluated the alignment of Rapp Road relative to the 1910 Survey and evidence of ownership along the road. We found that the record data fit the existing evidence of ownership very well. We held the 1910 road P.I. for the east end of Rapp Road and the centerline Wagner Creek Road as previously discussed for the West end. The centerline alignment was rotated about the 1910 road P.I. to be 20 feet north of a found 1/2 inch iron pipe (not of record) on the south right of way of Rapp Road. The pipe fit the record data and existing evidence of ownership very closely. We then proportioned the record distances along Rapp Road to fit the actual distance we used. Survey monuments for the subdivision were then set as shown on the attached drawing.
