Location: Section 28, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose of Survey:

To survey and describe four parcels of land, each parcel to be five acres or more.

Procedure: Found quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 28, also found section corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 and 29. Measured distance between said corners and found same to be 2646 feet.

Established northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter at mid point (1323 feet).

The deflection angle at the County Road indicates the road bearing to be North 89° 18' 30" West while the north line of Section 28 bears South 89° 59' 30" West. The north and south lines for the parcels surveyed were porportioned accordingly.

Parcel indicated as "B" in narrative dated June 1955, was extended west 674 feet more or less to a fence for a total of 16.362 acres more or less.

Parcels "C" and "D" were staked for 5.000 acres each.
