

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: William Hinkle

LOCATION: The S.W.1/4 S.E.1/4 Sec. 15, T 39 S, Ri E

PURPOSE: To monument the corners and boundaries of the tract described in Document No. 80-26227 of the Official Records.

PROCEEDURE: The S.W.1/4 S.E. 1/4 was determined from found monuments of recorded surveys no. 8607 and 9294 and using calculated sectional subdivision data from recorded survey no 8607. Said tract was then established according to deed record distance from the East boundary of said S.W.1/4 S.E.1/4. The Northwesterly portion of said tract boundary was established by holding deed record bearing. There is a physical gap of approx. 35 Feet between the North boundary of the S.W.1/4 S.E.1/4 and a existing East-West fence line as shown on the accompanying map. Monuments of recorded survey no. 1641 were not investigated, but inspection of L.E. Ager's records indicate that he used the 3/4" iron pipe found near the N.E. corner of the tract herein surveyed as control for survey no. 1641, which follows said East-West fence. Also, evidence indicates that this 3/4" iron pipe and fence line predates Ager's survey no. 1641.
