An iron pin, 5/8inch diameter bears  $5.0^{\circ}07^{\circ}E_{\circ}$ , 19.88 feet.

A white Oak, 48 inch diameter bears S  $62^{0}17^{7}E.$ , 263.3 feet.

A Black Oak, 22 inch diameter bears N  $28^{0}39^{+}$  W., I69.0 feet.
