

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

## Procedure

Existing survey control established during the course of Surveys No. 3558, 4675 and 8206 was utilized and produced Northerly closing Northwesterly on Survey No. 6958 and Northeasterly along the west line of Survey No. 4338 as found to be monumented.

The agreement line described in Jackson County Official Record No. 73-12733 begins at the N 1/16 corner common to Sections 32 and 33 and terminates on the west line of Cantrall-Buckley Park at a 1½ iron pipe. Said pipe was found to measure 1½ (inside diameter) and intended to control the point of line termination, according to Mr. Marion Dunlap, as established by himself and Mr. Floyd Fogelquist prior to execution of the line agreement.

Mr. Dunlap also stated that the true 1/16 corner was intended to control the point of beginning inasmuch as the physical location of said corner was not determined at the time although the 1909 witness tree was known and believed to accurately reference the true position.

Accordingly, the 1909 1/16 corner (See Survey No. 6958) was held subordinate to the true corner position as determined by this survey.

The monument on the division line between parcels falls approximately 50 feet West of Dunlap Road.
