

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

NW ¼ of Section 34, T.32 S.,R. 1E., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon

BASIS OF BEARINGS: West boundary of Section 34 per filed survey No. 730.

**PURPOSE:** 

- 1. To monument and reference the NW corner of the South-half of the SW ¼ of the NW ¼ of the NW ¼, the NE corner of the NW ¼ of the NE & of the NW & of the NW & and an approximate position for the SE corner of the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of section 34, T.32 S.,R. 1E., W.M.
- 2. To mark a computed, approximate location for the Southeasterly boundary and a portion of the East boundary of tract 314 as described in Instrument No. 74-08008 O.R. . These boundaries were marked with blazed and painted trees and B.C.C. property line tags nailed to the base of trees, on logs and on stumps.

Utilizing a one-second theodolite and E.D.M. equipment, ties were made to monuments set on filed survey No. 730 as shown on the annexed map.

A subdivision of Section 34 was computed based on record information from Filed Survey No's 730 and 8404. A combination of these two surveys incompass the West, North and East boundary of Section 34. A computed South boundary agrees closely with a Boise Cascade personel unrecorded survey of this boundary (no evidence of the original South & corner was found).

A closed traverse was ran near the line to be marked. The corners monumented and referenced on this survey are as follows:

At the computed approximate position for the SE corner of the NW & of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 34, set a 3/4" x 24" galvanized iron pipe 22" in the ground with a 2" br. cap marked:

A 6" black oak scribed "  $\chi$  BT" on one low blaze bears S 44 3/4° E, 8.2 feet to the center.

A 8" fir scribed "  $\chi$  BT" on one low blaze bears S 28 3/40 W, 23.1 feet to the center.

At the NW corner of the South-half of the SW & of the NW & of the NW ¼ of Section 34, set a 3/4" x 24" galvanized iron pipe 22" in the ground with a 2 ' br. cap marked:

A 11" fir scribed"1/256 S 34 BT" on one low blaze bears N  $18^{0}$  F. 18.8 feet to the center.

A 7" fir scribed" $1/256~\rm S$  33 BT" on one low blaze bears N  $68^{\rm O}$  W. 4.9 feet to the center.

At the NE corner of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, set a 3/4" x 24" galvanized iron pipe 22" in the ground with a 2" br. cap marked:

A 8" fir scribed"1/256 S 34 BT" on one low blaze bears S  $45^{0}$  E, 47.7 feet to the center.

A 6" fir scribed"1/256 S 27 BT" on one low blaze bears N  $57 \frac{9}{4}$  W, 17.2 feet to the center.

New references to the 1" galvanized iron pipe with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pot metal filled expander found set for the West one-sixteenth corner common to section 27 and 34 (see county surveyor intermediate corner book) are as follows:

 $\,$  A 10" laurel scribed "W 1/16 S 27 BT" on one low blaze bears N 23  $^{0}$  E, 16.3 feet to the center.

A 8" fir scribed "W 1/16 S 34 BT" on one low blaze bears S  $74^{0}$  E, 10.0 feet to the center.
