SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 ORECON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Timothy J. Rutter 558 Holly Street Ashland, OR 97520

LOCATION:

Situated in Government Lot 4 in the Southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian,

Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and partition into two (2) parcels that tract or parcel of land as set forth in Crater Title Insurance Company policy No. 43703. Also, to prepare a legal description for Parcel No. 1.

PROCEDURE:

Commenced this survey in the vicinity of Holly and Idaho Streets from control previously established by this surveyor. Traversed to the area of this survey and tied those found monuments as shown on Recorded Survey No. 1511 and monuments thought to have been set by F. Walker on a survey he made on February 26, 1937 and set forth in Field Book 'U' at page 41, this field book being in the possession of the City of Ashland Engineering Department. In researching the chain of title some differences in boundary positions were found to exist inasmuch as the original conveyences started from the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 39 and then were changed to start from the Southwest corner of Government Lot 4, said Township and Range. This change created an overlap problem between that land as described in Volume 10, page 711 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon and that land as described in Volume 151, page 629 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. It appears that F. Walker made his survey in 1937 ignoring the senior title line as was established in that prior conveyence as set forth in Volume 10, page 711 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. The East boundary line of Parcel No. 2 fits very well the deed which was described from the Southwest corner of Government Lot 4 and as surveyed by F. Walker. However, the deed record overlap is a matter of fact and the client has been advised as to what courses of action he may want to pursue at a later point in time. The remainder of the survey is as shown on the accompanying map.

BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 9 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
