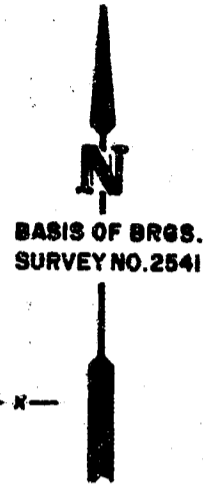
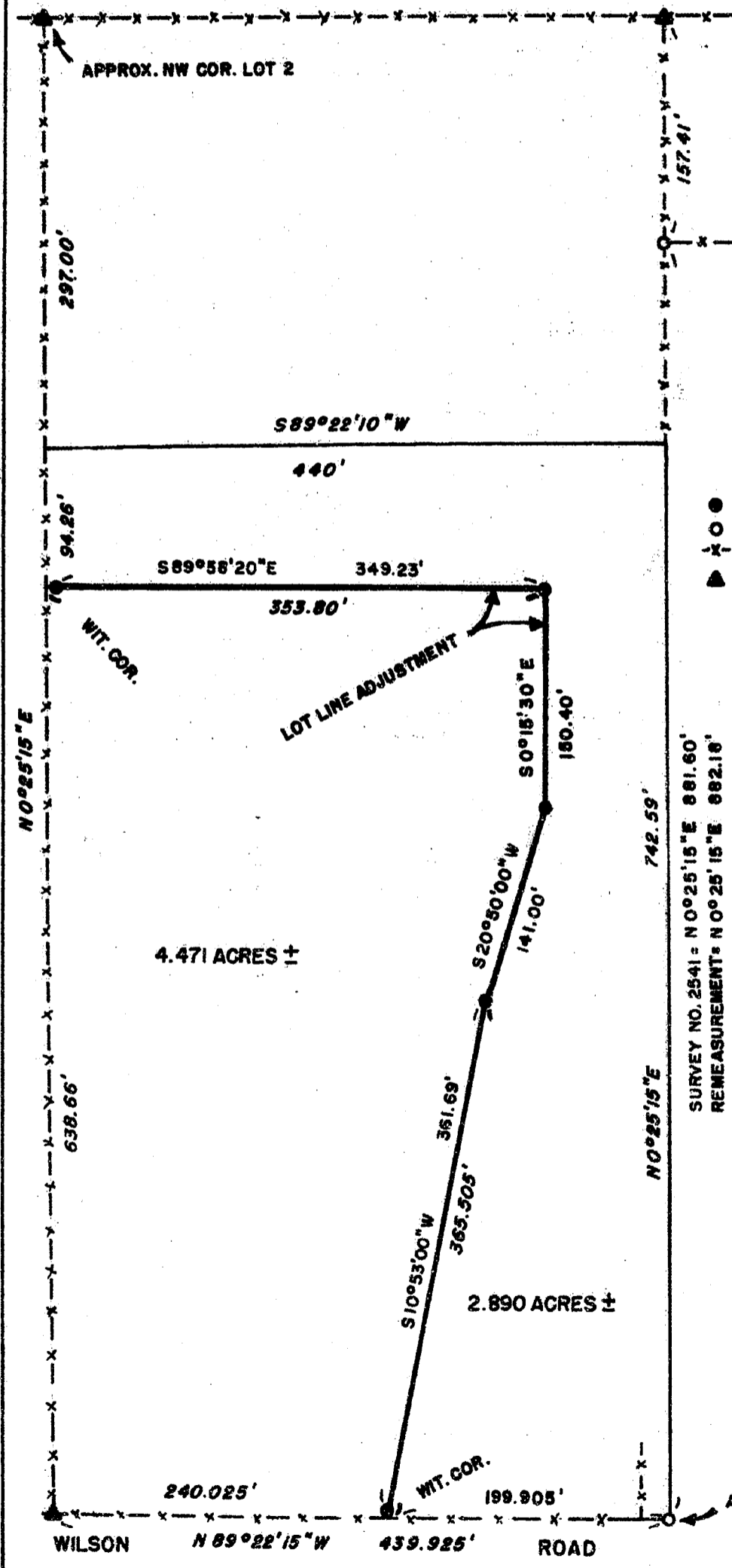


SURVEY IN LOT 2 OF BLOCK "K", ROGUE RIVER VALLEY ORCHARD COMPANY TRACTS

Bearings : Based on monuments found as shown on the attached plat.

Purpose : To monument a lot line adjustment in accordance with
instructions issued by the client.

Procedure

Since a boundary line agreement was never executed following Survey No. 2541, said survey must be considered as defining the lines of occupation and not necessarily the true lines as might be determined by an extensive retracement of the original subdivision.

Accordingly, witness corners were set as shown on the adjusted lot line with the relationship to the lines of occupation indicated.

The client is aware that this is not a comprehensive survey and in fact did not desire that such be made.

Reference is made to the plat and narrative (Survey No. 2541) on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor for additional information.
