

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

William H. MacKenzie 2040 Pleasant Creek Road Rogue River, Oregon 97537

LOCATION:

Northeast one-quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of Northwest one-quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of Section 3, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the parcels of land per client's request as shown on the attached map of survey

PROCEDURE:

Using found monumentation, as shown on the attached map of survey, I surveyed the Northwest one-quarter $\binom{1}{4}$ of Section 3. Then using the measured distances and information from the G.L.O. survey notes of Section 3, I used proportioned distances to subdivide the Northwest one-quarter $\binom{1}{4}$ of Section 3. I set monuments as shown on the attached map of survey.

For the Section corner common to Sections 33 and 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, and Sections 3 and 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian I found 2½" brass cap, flush, at fence corner. The brass cap has large scratch, is leaning Westerly and is turned 90°, to point West. I checked distances to bearing trees and a found 5/8" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "Jackson Co. C.S." which bears South 82° 53' West 24.10 feet, could not locate other 5/8" rebar reference per 1984 County re-estab notes.
