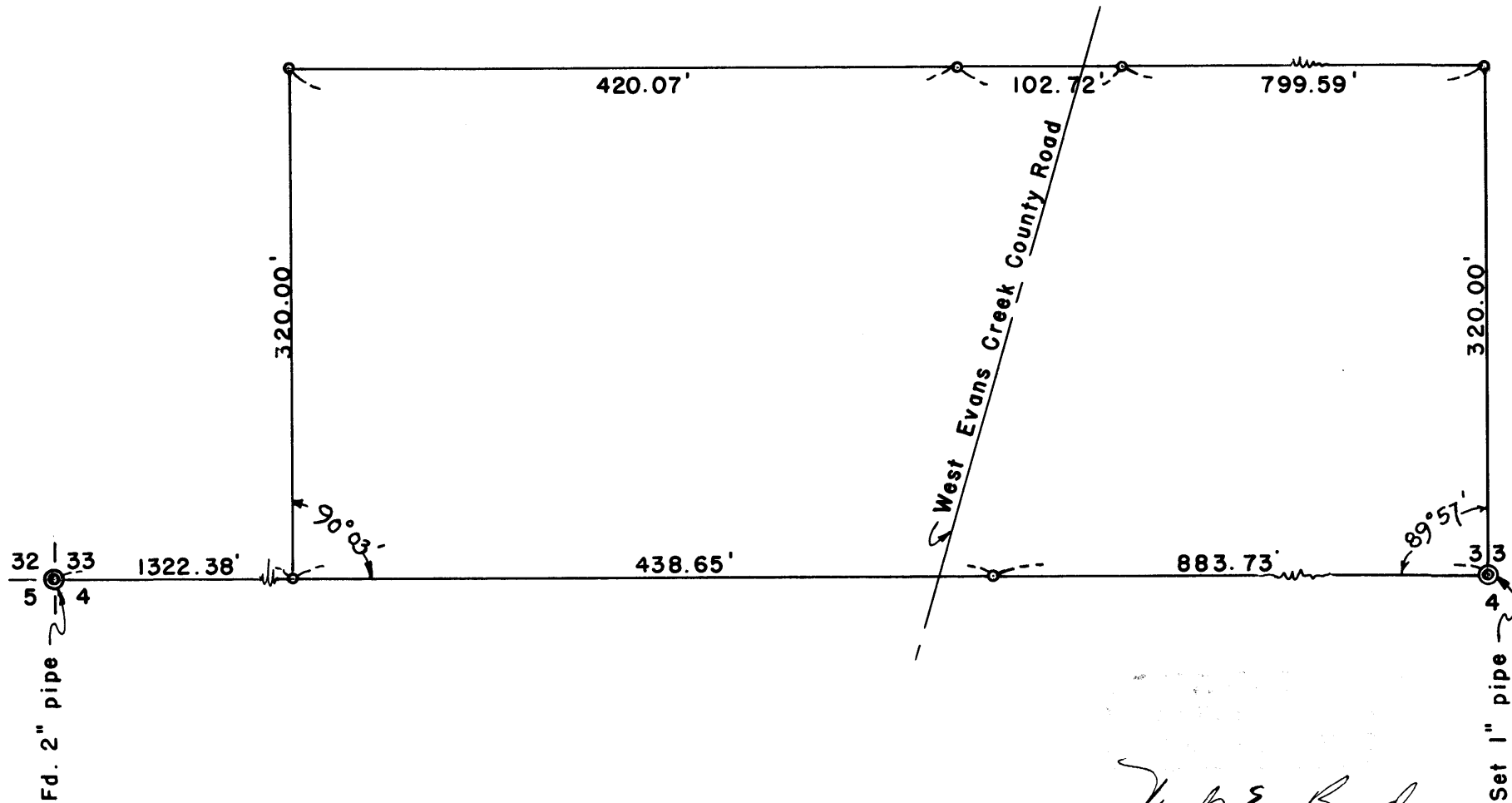
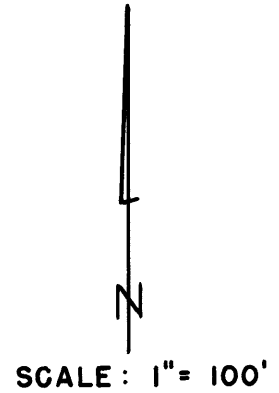

Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250,
Oregon Revised Statutes

FOR: Henrietta and Myrtle Oliver

PURPOSE: To monument the South 320 feet of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, and to also monument the North and South boundaries near the West Evans Creek County Road.

PROCEDURE: Commenced at the 2" galvanized iron pipe re-established Southwest corner of said Section 33, and traversed Easterly to the South Quarter corner of said Section, where the original witness trees were found (see official re-establishment record).

Set monuments as shown on the attached map, explaining, however to Miss Oliver, that the Northwest and Northeast corner monuments are subject to minor East-West change when Section 33 is accurately protracted.
