

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Abdol Hamid Ghavam 195 Morton Street Ashland, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument the corners of two tracts described in a contract of sale encompassing tax lot 1000-39-1E-9DB. Note: the client and I were personally informed by the City of Ashland Planning Director that this apparent seperation does not constitute a Minor Land Partition.

PROCEEDURE: The found City centerline street monuments were used as control for establishing the West line of Morton Street, the North line of Iowa Street and the Southerly boundary of Hunsaker's Addn. according to record distance. The West line of said tracts were held parallel to Morton Street and the South line was held parallel to Iowa Street, using record distance North from Iowa Street. The angle point on the Southerly boundary of the 16.00 foot Alley was established at record distance (78.50 feet) from the intersection of the original alley line with the West line of Morton Street.
