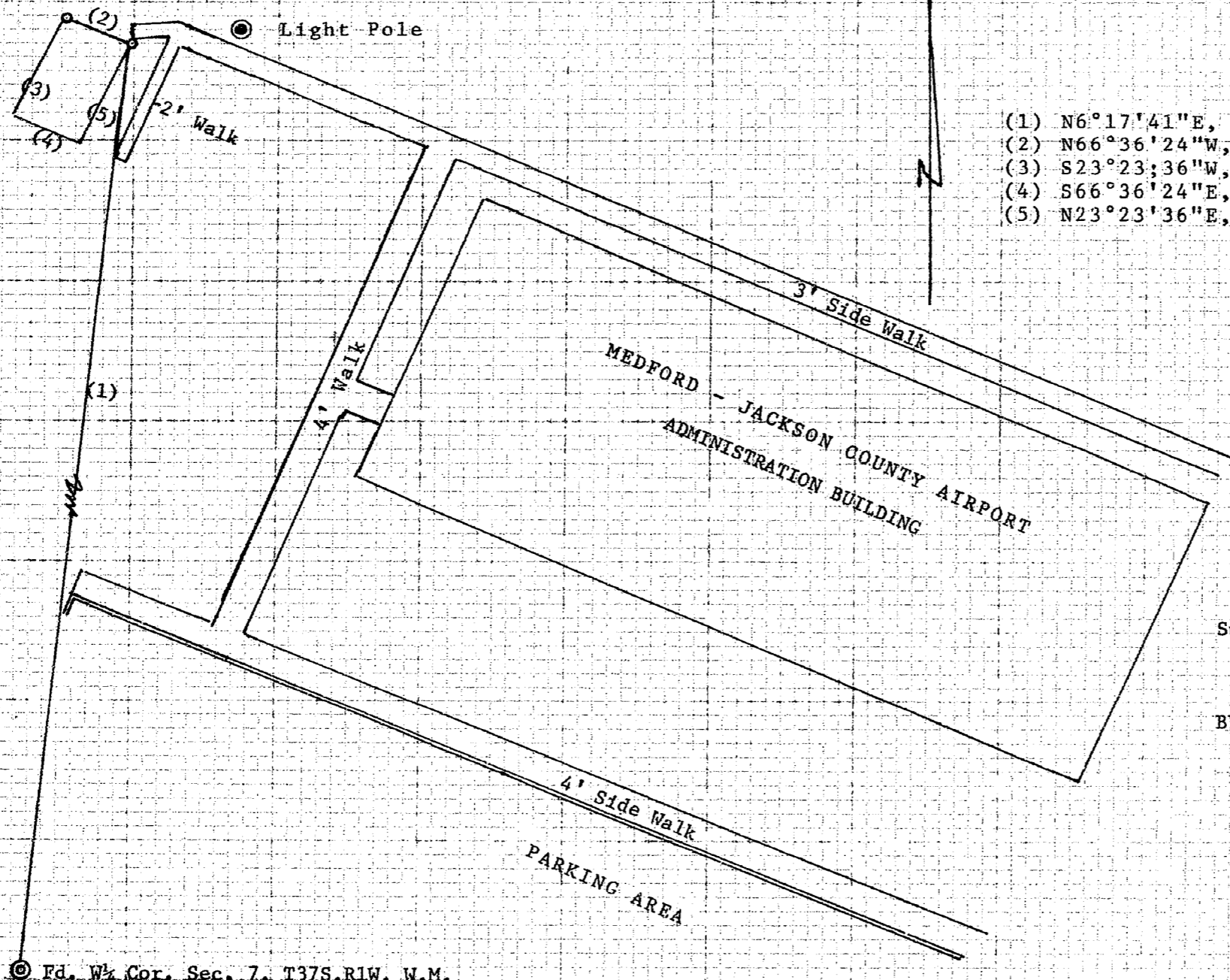

LOCATION: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 37 South, Range 1 West of
the Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.

DATE: February 18, 1986

BASIS OF BEARING: Determined from coordinates of previous traverse.
Beacon triangle station to West quarter of Section 7,
N60°03'55"E, 309.75 ft.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY: This tract was surveyed and a description was prepared for
the purpose of a lease agreement with the telephone company, which they propose
to use for building site to house telephone equipment.

MONUMENTS: At the West quarter corner of Section 7, found C.S. brass
disc, approximately 2 inches below the paved surface.
Monuments set being two 5/8 inch iron pins, 24 inches long,
set flush with attached plastic caps marked Jackson C.S.
