

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES.

SURVEY FOR: John Durbin & Terry Josephson 5235 Kane Creek Road Gold Hill, Ore. 97525

ICCATION: Southwest 1/4 of Section 35, Township 36 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: Survey and monument two tax lots per deed records.

PROCEDURE: Section 35 was subdivided by Lloyd R. Moffit in 1983, Recorded Survey No. 982h. I therefore begin at the South 1/h corner and traverse North to an iron pin marking the Northeast corner of Geiszler property. Thence I traverse West to the Northwest corner of Geiszler property. I then calculate bearings and distances between found pins and agree with measurements shown on R.S. 982h plat. I then survey perimeters of the two tax lots as shown on the accompanying plat and set property corners as indicated. Acceptable closures on both parcels by present standards. Set 5/8" x 24" steel pins with yellow plastic caps stamped "D.W. EDMARDS-IS 741".
