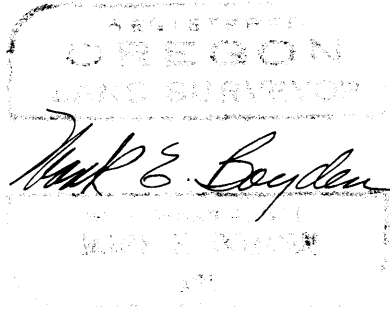
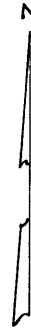

## Survey Narrative to Comply with Paragraph 209.250,

## Oregon Revised Statutes

FOR: J. W. Burba

PURPOSE: To establish two point for line control only on the West line of the East one-half of Lot No. 12 of Block No. 1, JACKSON'S ADDITION to Medford.

PROCEDURE: Used the controls established on surveys No. 749 and 994 to locate Cottage and Myrtle streets. Then established a line from the East boundary of Cottage Street to the West boundary of Myrtle Street, said line being 15.0 feet Southerly from and parallel to the South line of Lot No. 4 of Army Subdivision as the same was established on Survey No. 564. Determined the distance between the two above mentioned streets and their angle of divergence and then by proportioning, determined the desired line without definite terminus at either end. Set two iron pins as shown on the map to accompany this report.
