

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Location:

Northwest quarter of Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon. The monument also monuments the intersection of Ashland and Terrace Streets in the City of Ashland.

Purpose:

To replace the west 1/16 corner common to Sections 9 and 16 which was destroyed by water main construction in April of 1986.

Procedure:

A 7/8 inch square iron bar, 28 inches deep was found monumenting the west 1/16 corner common to Sections 9 and 16 of said township and range. The corner was last visited by the City of Ashland Engineering Personnel on April 26, 1984 at which time reference ties were made utilizing a 1 second theodolite and 100 foot steel tape. The ties were recorded in City of Ashland field book no. 101 page 42.

Upon destruction of the original corner a 2-inch pipe with 3 inch diameter brass disk was set in its place as shown on the accompanying map.
