
History of original corner establishment:

The original corner position for Sections 2 and 3, Township 38 South, and Sections 34 and 35, Township 37 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, was established by Sewall Truax under contract No. 80, dated July 8, 1859.

This corner position was remonumented from original evidence by Richard Templin, R.E. 3024, during Jackson County Record Survey No. 4948 A, dated September 28, 1972.



Description of corner evidence found: At the corner point, I found a 5/8-inch diameter iron pin with a plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN" RE 3024," and the following accessories:

A 16-inch diameter fir bears S.38°58'E., 25.40 feet distance, with scribing R3BT visible on a partly-healed blaze.

A root hole bears S.24°02'E., 14.20 feet distance, with a rotted fir alongside, and reverse scribing R3T38 visible on a loose piece of wood (original tree).

A 20-inch diameter fir bears S.68°04'W., 10.40 feet distance,

with scribing 24 BT visible on a partly-healed blaze.

A 17-inch diameter fir bears N.27°07'W., 19.50 feet distance,

with fragmentary scribing visible on a partly-healed blaze.

A 21-inch diameter fir bears N.37°12'E., 2.20 feet distance, with

scribing BT visible on a partly-healed blaze.

A 32-inch diameter fir bears N.45°04'E., 45.60 feet distance, with scribing T37 visible on a decayed face (original tree).

Description of monument and occessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner
At the corner point, directly over the found 5/8-inch diameter
iron pin, I drove a 1-inch (inside diameter) iron post with a
3-inch diameter bronze disk cemented on top, and marked as shown
in diagram. I surrounded monument with a small mound of stone.

The original corner position for Sections 1, 2, 11, and 12, Township 38 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, was established by Sewall Trust under Contract No. 80, dated July 8, 1859.

This corner position was remonumented from original evidence by the Bureau of Land Management. Division of Cadastral Surveys in 1965.

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Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point, I found a standard B.L.M. brass cap monument marked as shown in diagram, and the following accessories:

A 13-inch diameter fir bears S.14°07'E., 6.20 feet distance, with a healed blaze.

A 14-inch diameter fir bears S.50°10'W., 35.40 feet distance, with a healed blaze.

An 8-inch diameter fir bears N.71°46'W., 45.20 feet distance, with scribing SR3ES2BT visible. This tree is now dead.

A 30-inch diameter sawed fir stump bears N.66°12'W., 38.00 feet distance, with scribing BT visible (original bearing tree).

An 11-inch diameter fir bears N.07°14'E., 29.30 feet distance, with a healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I stabilized the monument as needed and marked the following accessory:

A 13-inch diameter fir bears N.41°24'W., 58.30 feet distance, scribed T38SR3ES2 LS1071 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point, as verified by Surveyor Truax's topographic calls, I found the original accessories:

A root hole, with a dead and down fir alongside, with scribing 1/4S BT visible in a healed blaze. (Original NW bearing tree bears record N.74°00'W., 33 lks, [21.73 feet] distance.)

A root hole, with the rotted center of the tree still remaining, bears N.74°00'E., 12 lks (7.92 feet distance.)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner point, as determined by distances and verfied by bearings to the original accessories, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ -inch diameter iron post with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ -inch diameter brass cap monument marked as shown in diagram, 26 inches in the ground. I surround monument with a mound of stone and mark the following accessories:

A 12-inch diameter fir bears S.68°38'E., 32.90 feet distance, scribed 1/451 LS1071 BT.

A 12-inch diameter fir bears N.35°28'W., 16.60 feet distance, scribed 4482, LS1071 BT.


