NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, T. 36 S., R. 1 W. WM, Eagle Point, Jackson County, Oregon. (Tax Lot No. 36 1 W. 3B - 301 and 400)

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe 3 parcels of an approved "Minor Land Partition" (see City of Eagle Point File No. 17-86).

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a one-second theodolite and EDM equipment, ties were made to State Highway right-of-way monumentation shown on Filed Survey No. 10538, the Northwest corner of section 3 and found monuments shown on the annexed map.

3/4" iron pipes found set on Filed Survey No. 129 were held for control of the Northerly boundary of Vol. 574, Page 188 Deed Records. The 5/8" rebar with plastic cap found set for a witness corner to the Southwest corner of Filed Survey No. 10203 was held for control of the Southerly boundary of Inst. No. 85-09996 O.R.. The Linn Road right-of-way line was established from Jackson County Public Works Dept. spikes found set for center line PI's (see Linn Road survey notes dated September, 1965 in the County Surveyors Office). This location was recently legalized at the clients request to County Public Works, see Inst. No. 86-23685 O.R.. The Crater Lake Highway Right-of-way line was located from found O.S.H.D. right-of-way monuments.

Parcel No. 2 was located to coincide with Tract "B" (an easement and right-of-way for purposes of ingress and egress) as described in said Inst. No. 85-09996 D.R..
