SURVEY NARRATIVE

The Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and the Southwest LOCATION:

PURPOSE:

The initial purpose for this survey is to establish and monument corners of two preexisting, developed percels owned by Joyce J. Peek and Richard R. Peek. Together, these two parcels describe the North 520 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 2 lying West of Humbug Creek Road. Field survey showed an encroachment on the West line of the Peek's percels with possession following a fence as shown on the accompanying plat. This survey shows both the record corners and the corners as per a proposed boundary line adjustment. This proposed adjustment changes the boundary between percels owned by Mr. and Mrs. Pook and Mr. Richard D. and Jill D. Marcoulier, contreet purchaser in possession of the Southwest querter of the Northeast querter of said Section 2. It also changes the boundary ecommon to the two percels owned by Mr. and Mrs. Peek. I also located outbuildings in the possession of Mr. Marcoulier in encreashment and a fence line that appeared to mark current possession, lifter Mr. Mercoulier and Mrs. Peak reached agreement on an exchange of property to eliminate the encreechment, I menumented the corners as per this agreement. Both sets of corners are shown on the accompanying plate Humbug Creek Reed was located as per Survey No. 3606.
